

Fundraising Policy 2024

Rational

Jacana School for Autism endeavours to support parents/carers and others who wish to support the community by raising funds. The opportunity for parents/carers to participate in fundraising strengthens home/school partnerships.

Purpose

To provide guidelines and protocols regarding the fundraising activities associated with the school.

Implementation

- The fundraising committee will operate in accordance with the *Constitution of Jacana School for Autism Parent/Carer Fundraising Committee*, and as per the Department requirements.
- The Principal oversees all fundraising operations across the whole school.
- There is one fundraising committee operating at Jacana School for Autism.
- All monies raised by each group are pooled.
- There is a base budget available to support fundraising. These funds must be replenished before a profit can be declared.
- Each fundraising group has a coordinator who liaises with the school Principal and fundraising committee president.
- The Principal, leadership team and fundraising committee president set the fundraising events and allocate dates on the school calendar.
- There will be up to two fundraising event each year outside school hours (for example, Bunning's BBQ)
- There will be two or more fundraising event each term (for example, Mothers' Day Stall, Christmas Raffle).
- There will be a maximum of one special lunch day fundraising event each term for students.
- Funds will not be raised by the sale of alcohol.
